7. Monitoring compliance with the agreement PABCO with the authority (Pig farm under official certification) that permit to export, PABCO is controlled by SAG.

8. Generate and sustain contacts with specialists from different disciplines in ministries, universities, laboratories for diagnostic, advisers, national and international.

9. Develop budget for the next year: it consider raw materials for all the diets for pigs, veterinary products, laboratory diagnosis, training program and Veterinary that work in the Health and Nutrition Department.
